Dear Parent/Carer

Following the announcement yesterday, we are pleased to be welcoming back your children on the 8th March. Our one-way system will remain operational and our collection and drop off times that were in place in the Autumn term will resume. **We are asking all parents, who are not exempt, to wear face masks on the school site at drop off and collection times please.**

It is still imperative that we minimise the number of adults on the school grounds and therefore ask that **only one adult drops off the children.** Please ensure you move swiftly off site and do not congregate around the entrance and exit gates to school. Please ensure that drop off and collection times are adhered to and that you maintain a 2 metre distance from those around you. Parking on the yellow zigzags at the school gate is prohibited and puts children at risk. Please refrain from doing this.

Children can once again come to school wearing their school kit for their PE day. A class letter will be sent out detailing the day your child will need to come wearing their PE kit. Please see the school website for the uniform requirements for children.

Attendance from the 8th March is compulsory and we will work with families to ensure that attendance at school is as high as possible. If you feel that there have been any particular safeguarding issues whilst we have been in lockdown, or your child has specific medical concerns that you want to discuss in relation to their return, please contact Mrs Brown or Mrs Hall.

There will be no access to the school building for any parent. If you have something that you wish to speak to a member of staff about, please either telephone or email the admin email and we will get back to you as soon as possible. **Please ensure the staggered drop off and pick times are adhered to, this will help us keep everyone safe and contact to a minimum.** In the case of an emergency, a parent may drop forgotten items at the main entrance door, but for the safety of our admin team we ask that parents do not use the office for any questions or queries and telephone, or email instead.

Breakfast club will resume for children on 8th March. The breakfast club is available for children from Reception (Red and Blue class) to Year 6. The charge for Breakfast Club is £1.50 a morning. **Places will need to be booked in advance.** Please contact our office if you require a place. Places will be allocated on a 'first come' basis. Children who already have a key worker breakfast place will automatically be booked in for the mornings they have been attending; please advise us if this needs to change.

Magic Breakfast will be served from the hall door for Y1 – Y6. All children will be offered toast that can be collected as they pass the hall door each morning. For children in our early years toast will be available in the classroom on arrival for all those who wish to take it. All allergies will be catered for by our kitchen. Children will continue to dine in their classrooms at lunchtime and meal times will be staggered across the school to ensure social distancing between bubbles as play times. Hot meals will be served by our kitchen. If you need to update any allergies for your child, please ensure you contact the school office

We have carried out extensive risk assessments and have taken every precaution to ensure that school is as safe as we can possibly make it. Our risk assessments are published on our website. All of our arrangements are in place to make our school as safe as it can be.
