Following the Prime Ministers announcement, school will be closed tomorrow but will be open to children of key workers and vulnerable children. If you informed us you were a key worker (and remain so) or vulnerable in the last lock down we already have your details and you will automatically be allocated a place. If your circumstances have changed and feel you qualify for a place, please contact the school office via email at hilderthorpe.primary@eastriding.gov.uk by 2pm tomorrow afternoon (5.01.21). A member of staff will contact you during the day.

Breakfast Club Provision will be offered for Key Worker Children **only** from 8am. If children are not attending Breakfast Club, they need to arrive at 9am and be collected at 3pm.

Drop off and Collection Points are as follows:

- Nursery and Reception Children need to enter through the Nursery Door
- Key Stage 1 children need to enter through the door in 2JH
- Key Stage 2 children need to enter through the KS2 door in the playground.

If you are entitled to a free school meal, please inform the office if you require this via telephone or email.

We appreciate that this is short notice, however I am sure that you will understand that we have responded as quickly as possible to the Government's Announcement at 8pm this evening. Learning will now move online via Purple Mash, please ensure that your child is able to access the online learning platform.

We will be in touch with further information to support you in your home learning tomorrow.
