Dear Parent/carers

Please find the below information for our next academic year. I appreciate this is a lengthy list, but it is important you are fully informed. As always some of these plans could be changed if there is a requirement for schools to adapt plans to support the reduction in transmission of COVID-19. In this instance you will always be informed at the earliest opportunity of any adaptations that are required.

Start and end times

- Breakfast club will continue to operate from 8am each day.
- The day will begin for all children at 8.55 and will finish at 3.20 for all children. For all children who are in our reception and new to our nursery, please continue with the times that are set out in your letter for your child's start at school.
- The doors to all classrooms will open from 8.45 to allow children to be ready for learning in their classroom. Please ensure your children are on time and ready to learn. We begin each day with reading, so it is important that children are here ready to learn.
- Toast will continue to be served from the hall doors each morning and will be sent to classrooms for our reception and nursery children.
- Children in Y3 will be ready to collect at 3.20 from beneath the canopy in the back playground. This will enable staff to safely hand over children to parents/carers as they make their first steps in KS2.
- Children in nursery and reception can be collected from 3.15 to enable parents who may need to collect older siblings from other classes.
- The one way system will remain in place to enter and exit the school site and for parents to circulate the main building.

During the day

- Playtimes will be staggered in phases (KS1, LKS2, UKS2) to ensure children can have increased space and can continue to access sports and play equipment. This will enable them to continue to engage in active play and games, which has been particularly successful in this year's planning.
- All children will dine in the hall.
- The school will maintain its current cleaning and hygiene measures next year.





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Equipment

- Bags may once again be brought to school and we ask that reading books are sent in each day. Please continue to work in partnership with us and hear your child read each day. Reading is an essential skill for your child.
- Please ensure children are dressed in their uniforms each day and wear the correct sports kit for PE. The uniform requirements can be found on our website. We have high expectations of behaviour and presentation and ask for your support with this. If you need any support with uniform please don't hesitate to speak to a member of the senior leadership team.
- Children will continue to be asked to arrive in their PE kit on their PE days. These days will be sent out via text to all parents on the 10th September and included in the curriculum newsletter.

Attendance

- It is compulsory for all children to attend school in September. Given the disruption to education it is incredibly important that your child is in school ready to learn each day. The pandemic has certainly presented us all with many challenges, but as a community we have remained resolute in our support of each other. On behalf of the staff and governors I would like to thank you for your support and kindness in these challenging times and wish you, and all the children, a wonderful summer.
