Dear Parents/Carers

As we await further news from the government I wanted to give you some reassurance of what has been happening behind the scenes to prepare for children who are self-isolating and in the event of closure.

We have been working hard as a team to put together learning resources for your children. In the event of closure, which has not yet been announced, home learning packs will be sent home with your child. This will enable you to continue a learning programme at home with your child. All the resources sent can also be found on the school website www.hilderthorpeprimaryschool.co.uk. Please click on the children tab at the top of the front page and scroll down to education packs. From there you will find all the resources for your child's year group. Resources will be continually uploaded in each year group area on the website.

If your child is self-isolating and you require a physical pack of learning then please contact the school office. They will be happy to post out your child's learning, or have it ready in the office for somebody who is not isolating to collect.

The advice from the government remains as below and we have had no direction that a school closure will happen at this time. School does remain open at present with the following guidance in place:

- If you live with others and you, or one of them, have symptoms of coronavirus, then all household members must stay at home and not leave the house for 14 days. Hygiene remains our primary focus and we will continue to keep in touch and update you as soon as we receive further information from the government.
